Parents,

This **Friday**, PreK-4th Grade Students will be allowed to wear Halloween costumes, Halloween accessories or Spirit shirts. Students must be able to use the restroom without assistance while wearing their costume. If a costume is worn, a spirit shirt or uniform shirt **MUST** be worn underneath. Students often get hot or tired of wearing the costume and they must be able to remain in uniform once they take the costume off. The following guidelines must be adhered to: **NO** face paint, body paint, glitter, graphic or gory content, or weapons. Students must be able to sit/fit in their desk and need to wear uniform shoes.

5th - 7th Grade Students will be allowed to wear Halloween accessories and Spirit Shirts on Friday, October 29. The following guidelines must be adhered to: **NO** face paint, body paint, or glitter.

Additionally, all treats and bags are being provided by funds you submitted in tuition designated for "field trips". 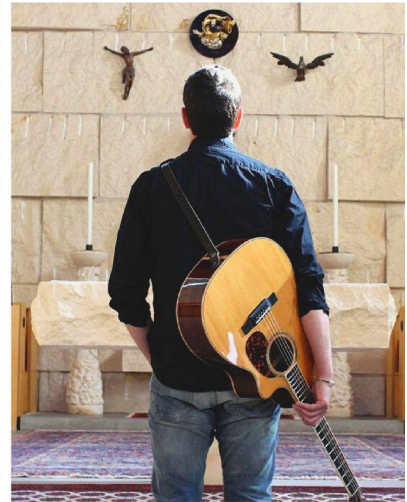
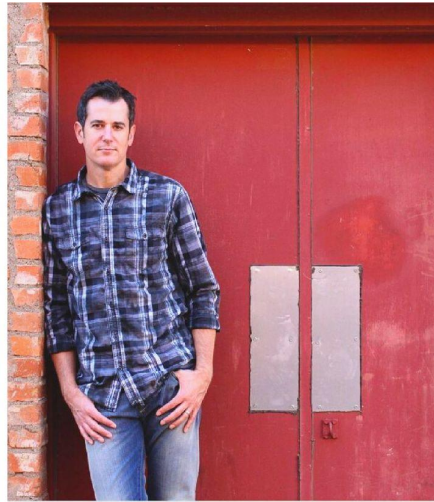
