

Prior to arrival to school each day, parents are required to complete a personal health assessment for each child. Sending a child to school confirms that he/she is in good health. If any of the following symptoms are present, please keep your child home and call the school office.

Please check your student for these symptoms:

1. Does your child have a temperature of 100.4 or above?
2. New headache
3. New cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
4. Sore Throat, Runny Nose
5. Diarrhea, Vomiting, or Abdominal Pain

Complete the COVID reporting form under Parents/ Important Links on the school website:

1. Develops COVID-19 symptoms
2. Is diagnosed with COVID -19
3. Is waiting on test results
4. Has a family member with a positive Covid-19 test or waiting for the test results living in the same household.
5. Has been in close contact to a person with COVID - 19 symptoms or a positive test. Close contact is within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes during the infectious period, which includes the 48 hours before the day the person became sick (or the 48 hours before specimen collection if asymptomatic) until the person was isolated. The use of a face covering is not a factor in determining close contacts.
