Parents,

The primary purpose of conferences is for parents and teachers to work in partnership to address any issues or concerns involving the student. If you do not have any specific issues or concerns to address, a conference is not needed at this time.

Parent-Teacher conferences will be held the last week of October. The online conference sign-up for on-campus conferences will open on October 18 at 8:00p.m. and will close on October 21 at 8:00 p.m. Please follow the directives on the sign-up as you will need to email the sign-up administrator for any changes. If you would prefer to have a phone conference, please email the teacher to schedule a time. See the information below for grade level specifics. **Only students in grades who are scheduled for a regular school day will be allowed on campus.**

Please note that all conferences will be with individual teachers. There will be no grade level or multiple teacher conferences. Each teacher will have a separate sign-up. Please make sure you sign-up under the correct teacher.

**Grades PK-4:** Parent-Teacher Conference Day for students in grades PK-4 will be held on Friday, October 28. Students in grades PK-4 will not have school on this day. Parents should sign up for ONE conference spot per child. For grades 3 & 4, please choose one teacher to conference with. The paired teachers will share information before and after conferences to make sure everyone is involved.

**Grades 5-8:** Parent-Teacher Conference days for students in grades 5-8 will be held for 1/2 day on Wednesday, October 26 and all day on Thursday, October 27. Students in grades 5-8 will not have school on the 26<sup>th</sup> or 27<sup>th</sup>. Parents may sign-up for a **maximum of 2 individual teacher conferences**. If there is an issue that requires a conference with MORE than 2 teachers, please reach out to your grade level counselor.

**FIELD TRIP CHAPERONES-** All field trip chaperones must be completely Child Protection Certified. When a field trip is announced, respond to the teacher promptly if you are interested in attending. Volunteers will be vetted through the Child Protection Coordinator. You will be contacted if your certification is not up to date. **Once a name is submitted, another adult cannot serve as a substitute.**

On the morning of the trip, there will be a table set up in front of the school office. Please pass by, pick up your Chaperone name tag and sign the chaperone sheet. If you are meeting the class at the site of the field trip, another chaperone may pick up your tag for you. **Siblings of students may not attend the trip. Adults who have not been vetted and issued a name tag may not attend the trip.**
