Family Tent Area Rules:

- Set up after **8:30AM** on **Friday, October 28**
- No balloons (arches, decorations, etc.) allowed
- No generators larger than a backpack generator
- Generators must have a drip pan or large cardboard base to protect the field from leaking gas and must be refilled off the field
- No extension cords
- No open flames/fire (e.g., fire pits)
- No glass
- No outside food or beverages (except birthday cakes)
- BYO tents must not exceed 10X10, must have tent weights
- All tent items and trash (including BYO tents) must be removed by **4PM** on **Sunday, October 30**
