CARPOOL REMINDERS AND SAFETY UPDATES: The administration has been made aware of multiple carpool incidents over the last several weeks. St. Aloysius School requests the following of all adults who drop off and pick up students in carpool:

-Please exercise patience during carpool. St. Aloysius Faculty and Staff should be treated with respect at all times. Our faculty and staff work hard to ensure that students are quickly, but safely entering and exiting our campus. At this point in the school year, all students are aware of their assigned sections for afternoon carpool and should be attentive when listening for numbers to be called.

-Please be courteous to other parents and neighbors of the school. We ask that everyone exhibit proper Christian behavior, and refrain from cutting the line or using inappropriate language. While the streets around our campus are geographically challenging for carpool, please do not drive onto the property of our neighbors.

-For safety reasons, students should enter and exit their cars on the passenger side only.

-Please adhere to all traffic laws during carpool. Cell phone use is strictly prohibited in school zones.

Parents, we ask that you please forward this information to any caregivers, such as grandparents or babysitters, who assist you with transportation to and from school. Thank you so much for your attention to this matter as we continue to partner with you in the Christian formation of your child.

HALLOWEEN COSTUMES- All students will be allowed to wear Halloween costumes and/or Halloween accessories on Monday, October 31. Spirit shirts may also be worn on this day. All students must follow the guidelines below. We encourage you to send your child in last year's Halloween costume because we cannot guarantee that all the parts of the costume will come home after school, and we do not want children to be disappointed when they get ready to go out for trick or treating at night. Students must be able to go to the bathroom without assistance while wearing their costume. If a costume is worn, a spirit shirt or uniform shirt **MUST** be worn underneath. Students often get hot or tired of wearing the costume and they must be able to remain in uniform once they take the costume off.

Guidelines: No face paint or body paint, No glitter, No masks, No graphic or gory content, No colored contacts, No weapons, Student must be able to sit/fit in desk, Student must wear uniform shoes

GRADE LEVEL MASS- Second grade will celebrate mass on Wednesday, October 26 at 8:15 am. Mrs. Griffin's class is facilitating. Parents, grandparents and friends of second graders are welcome to attend and may sit with their children for mass.

ALL SAINTS' DAY MASS- The St. Aloysius School community will celebrate the Feast of All Saints on Tuesday, November 1. Grades 2-8 will attend.

Seating- The mass will begin promptly at 8:00. This is a parish mass. There will be a reserved seating area for Parishioners. Parents of the seventh grade class facilitating the mass and 6th grade choir and cantors may sit in the area near the choir. **All other parents are to be seated in the area reserved for Parishioners,** not with the classes.

Food Bank- As with every All School Mass, we are collecting food for the Greater Baton Rouge Food Bank. With Thanksgiving approaching, this collection is even more special.

BOOK OF LIFE- Each homeroom will prepare a page for the *Book of Life*. Parent letters were distributed through the homeroom teachers. Parents are asked to return names by Friday, October 28. The *Book of Life* will be displayed at the All Saints Day Mass on Tuesday and in the school office throughout the month of November. We will keep all of our loved ones in our prayers.
