DETENTION REMINDER: Detention takes place on Thursday mornings in the Cafeteria. Students report to detention by 6:40, and they are dismissed when their assignment is complete at 7:30. Students will immediately report to the gym or the middle school walkway when they are finished.

PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES:

The primary purpose of conferences is for parents and teachers to work in partnership to address any issues or concerns involving the student. If you do not have any specific issues or concerns to address, a conference is not needed at this time.

GRANDPARENTS' DAY REMINDERS:


