Parents,

St. Aloysius School takes precautionary measures by practicing both fire drills and lockdown drills. Lockdown drills are used in a variety of situations: weather-related issues, an off campus incident, and/or identifying an individual on campus.

This Thursday will be the first “weather-related” lockdown drill, which historically has been the most common reason for a lockdown. The drill will be explained to the students Wednesday morning during assembly. It will entail following the direction of the teacher by moving away from windows. By calmly practicing the safest locations in the classroom, building, and/or campus in case of a weather emergency, we are all better prepared. This drill will last 10-15 minutes. Preparing and then debriefing afterwards provides learning opportunities for improvements. Each faculty and staff member will complete a debriefing questionnaire, which will then be compiled, discussed, and prioritized. The deputy on campus will assess and provide feedback also.

In the past, a lockdown has been called while an event is taking place off campus but in the vicinity of Southdowns/College Drive areas. Having a deputy on campus, he/she is able to alert us if a “situation” is happening nearby. Remaining in classrooms is the safest decision until the “all clear” is communicated.

In a similar manner, a lockdown may be necessary if we are unable to identify a visitor to our campus. Faculty and staff are vigilant in questioning and directing visitors to the main office for an official check in. The most common situations involve delivery drivers and individuals looking for the Childcare Center or the Church Office. These are handled swiftly; if the individuals are not able to be identified quickly, a lockdown may be required. As always, we will communicate with you.
