- **-Behavioral Expectations**: Remaining respectful to teachers and fellow classmates, behavior in the cafeteria, bathroom, and recess.
- **-Language**: In the aftermath of the tragic events that took place in Nashville several weeks ago, we reminded students that any threatening language towards other students or the school will be thoroughly investigated, and disciplinary consequences will be given.
- **-Social Media/Cyberbullying**: Gossip leads to misinformation about other people and situations. As Fr. Randy says, "Gossip is the work of the devil." Especially with the summer approaching, it is important for students to understand the proper way of using social media where it will not affect them negatively as a person and as a St. Aloysius student.


