STUDENTS IN GRADES 5-8: Report to school Thursday, August 5. School begins at 7:45am and ends at 2:50pm. Students are to report directly to their classroom. After care begins for Grades 5-8.

STUDENTS IN GRADES 1-4: Report to school Friday, August 6. School begins at 7:45am and ends at 2:50pm. Students are to report directly to their classroom. After care begins for Grades 1-4.

MASK MANDATE: As per the governor’s order, all students in Kindergarten through 8th Grade and adults will wear face coverings while indoors until September 1. Neck gaiters must be doubled.

BUS TRANSPORTATION: EBR bus transportation begins on August 11. The transportation office will send a postcard to each household with detailed bus route information in the days before bus service begins. Remember that all children riding the bus must wear a face covering.

August 5, 6, 9, and 10 bus riders will be dropped off and picked up in the administration building parking lot off Mimosa Street.

CARPOOL TAG INFORMATION: Carpool tags will be sent home with the youngest and/or only child in each family on the first day of school. If needed, please write your family carpool number on a sheet of paper in black marker for the first day of school.

CAFETERIA NEWS: All students are eating lunch and breakfast FREE during the 2021-2022 school year. Students that are not eating a full lunch will be charged for buying a la carte items, such as just milk, water, and any other extras. Students will need to have extra money in their accounts to buy extra items.
