<u>CAFETERIA NEWS:</u> Please ensure that all outstanding cafeteria balances are paid in full no later than 5/19/23. Payments made by check must be received no later than 5/5/23. After this date, payments may only be made via the <u>myschoolbucks.com</u> portal or cash. If you choose to send cash funds with your student, they must be in a sealed envelope with your student's name and grade.

Requests for refunds must be submitted by 5/14/23: You may elect to receive a refund of unused funds via check or request a transfer of funds to a sibling. TRANSPORTATION NEWS:

Bus Transportation for 2023-2024: EBR has requested that any parent who intends for their child(ren) to ride one of their buses next school year access **THIS LINK**. Please complete this form only if you intend for your child(ren) to ride. You do not have to enter anything for a state issued student ID, and the building code is 502015. The form is due on Friday, May 12th.

<u>Carpool Transportation:</u> BRPD has asked us to remind all of our parents that only vehicles with age-appropriate child restraints may be used to transport students to and from school. East Baton Rouge Parish and the city of Baton Rouge have not designated any roads for off-road vehicle use. Therefore, all off-road vehicles, such as golf carts, are not allowed for carpool transportation. Our officers will not allow students to ride on any off-road vehicles to leave school in the afternoons, and the vehicle may be towed due to illegal use. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

MORNING ARRIVAL: Students should arrive on campus between 7:15-7:40 each morning. Teachers report to duty by 7:15; therefore, no student should be dropped off or walk on to campus before 7:15 to ensure that there is proper supervision.

TUITION: When paying tuition via e-check through Gulf Coast Bank, there will be a 2-3 day processing fee. We understand this. As long as your payment is submitted by May 2nd, you will not incur a late fee. Loan applications must be submitted by May 2nd as well.

The Gulf Coast Tuition Website will be open March 29th. Tuition is NO LATER THAN **Tuesday, May 2, 2023** via E-Check through Gulf Coast Bank.

https://www.tuition.gulfbank.com/. Tuition loans must be applied for by that date as well. Current year loans must be paid in full in order to apply for a Gulf Coast tuition loan for 2023-2024. Tuition payments and loan applications after May 2nd will incur a \$50.00 (**per child**) late fee which must be paid directly to the school office before enrollment is complete.
