<u>CALENDAR FOR 2023-2024:</u> The process for providing next year's calendar is as follows: Once East Baton Rouge Parish Schools finalize its calendar, then the Diocese of Baton Rouge provides options due to the use of EBR school buses. SAS will create a calendar, based on the options, and send it to Fr. Randy and the diocese for approval. As soon as it is approved, we will send it to you; the final calendar is typically published late March-early April.


