- Dates must be entered in the format requested.

- You must initial each of the items in the Declaration section.

The information is entered into a diocesan database and the system will not accept partial information. The application will be returned to you for completion and thus delay the certification process. Once all requirements are complete, processing may take as long as two weeks.
