Hepatitis A Vaccination Information: The State of Louisiana Department of Health will begin verifying that all school-aged children have the Hepatitis A vaccination series beginning with the 2023-2024 school year. In order to attend a Louisiana school, a student must have received at least two doses (the shots must be at least six months apart). This vaccination has been required by the state but was not tracked until now.

Please check your student's immunization record to see if they have already received the two-dose series. If you do not have a copy of the current immunization record, please check with your pediatrician's office.

• If they have already received the two-dose Hepatitis A series, with the required minimum of six months between each vaccine, we do not need a new record. If they received the second vaccine before the six-month period, even by one day, the state does not consider them to be up to date. Please contact her pediatrician for guidance.

• If they have not received the first Hepatitis A vaccine, please schedule an appointment as soon as possible to begin the series. We will need a new record with each vaccine.

• If they have already received the first vaccine (and it has been six months or is approaching the six-month time frame), please schedule an appointment for the second and final dose before the start of the new school year.

• If you have decided to opt out of the Hepatitis A series, please contact the school nurses at:nurses@aloysius.org

A summary of vaccines from MyChart will not be accepted, as this is not a valid record for a school.

New records can be faxed to the school at 225-383-4500; you can email a scanned copy to nurses@aloysius.org; or you can deliver a hard copy to the school.
