

Lion's Roar: March 27, 2023 Parents,

The dress code, as stated in the Parent/Student Handbook, is listed below. We ask your assistance in evaluating your child's uniforms and grooming. The teachers have been instructed to enforce the dress code policies as well. If we all work together, this will be fixed immediately.

GIRLS:

Jumpers, **skirts**, **skorts**: Plaid jumpers may be worn by girls in Pre-K - 8. Uniform skirts/skorts may be worn by girls in 6 - 8. Jumpers/skirts/skorts are to be an appropriate length (no shorter than 2 inches above the knee). Girls in Pre-K and Kindergarten may wear the optional uniform dress. Shorts must be worn under the jumper, skirt, and dress.

Shorts: Plaid walking shorts may be worn by girls in Pre-K - 8. Walking shorts must be an appropriate length (no shorter than <u>2 inches</u> above the knee).

Blouses: White oxford pointed collar, short or long sleeve with logo, white uniform knit or dri-fit shirt with logo, or white-banded knit shirt with logo are acceptable. Girls in Pre-K-2 may wear the optional Peter Pan collar with navy blue piping. There are to be no initials on the shirts. If walking shorts/skirts/skorts are worn, blouse/knit shirts must be tucked inside (unless the banded knit shirt is worn). White turtlenecks may be worn **under** long sleeved blouses or sweatshirts during the winter. Solid white t-shirts may be worn under blouse/knit shirts. T-shirt sleeves may not be visible.

Sweaters (optional item): Navy cardigan or pullover uniform sweaters may be worn. **Non-uniform sweaters are not acceptable.**

Coats/Jackets:Only solid navy blue uniform jackets may be worn in the building. Either the traditional uniform jacket with a gray lining or the polar fleece jacket available in pull-over or zipper may be worn. No other jackets will be acceptable in the building. Students may wear any coat/jacket outside.

Sweatshirts and Sweatpants (optional items): Only navy St. Aloysius logo sweatshirts/sweatpants may be worn. St. Aloysius team sweatshirts may be worn in grades 3-8. These can be ordered at School Time. No other sweatshirt or sweatpant is acceptable. Grades 5 – 8 may purchase hooded sweatshirts-this includes sports sweatshirts. Grades Pre-K – 8 may also purchase St. Aloysius logo sweatpants. Sweatpants may NOT be worn under uniform jumpers or skirts. Sweatpants may only be worn on specified days. The dates for sweatpants will be announced each year depending on weather.

Shoes:Tennis shoes may be any color. Shoes may **not** have rollers, may **not** blink, and may **not** have sequins or shiny parts. Tennis shoes must have tied laces or Velcro straps. Slip on tennis shoes (mule or backless) are **not** allowed. Sandals, cleats, boots and turf type shoes are **not** allowed. Navy, black, or brown hard-soled shoes may also be worn.

Socks:Solid black or white <u>crew or ankle</u> socks. Socks must be visible, no shows are not acceptable. Small logos are allowed in black or white only. Grades Pre-K – 8 may wear solid navy blue, solid white, or solid black tights under the jumper or skirt in winter.

Jewelry: The only acceptable jewelry is a watch, one religious medal or one cross (may be worn on gold or silver chain or black/brown cord), and one piercing in each ear with simple post type earrings. High tech phone type watches and fitness bands may not be worn. Any device that has wireless capabilities and/or can receive notifications, text messages, or phone calls is not allowed.

Makeup/Grooming/Hair:Girls may not wear lipstick, blush, eye-shadow, eyeliner, or mascara. GIRLS IN THE 7TH AND 8TH GRADES MAY WEAR A LIGHT BASE ONLY. Fingernail polish is not acceptable. Hair MAY NOT be dyed, bleached, tinted, or highlighted.

Bows/Hair Accessories: Bows and hair accessories may be any color. Headbands must lay flat on the head. Costume style headbands are not allowed. Girls may wear a ponytail tie on one wrist. Scrunched style hair ties may not be worn on the wrist. Hair accessories or styles cannot distract from the learning environment.

BOYS:

Shirts:White uniform knit or dri-fit shirts with school logo are to be worn by boys in grades Pre-K – 8. Boys in grades 6 – 8 may wear oxford uniform shirts. **SHIRTS MUST BE TUCKED IN.** Solid white t-shirts may be worn under shirts. T-shirt sleeves may not be visible.

Pants: Dress model navy uniform pants (with or without pleats.) **DOCKERS, POLO, ETC. ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.** Pre-K-1 boys are encouraged to wear elastic waist uniform pants.

Shorts: Navy blue uniform shorts are to be appropriate length (no shorter than <u>2 inches</u> above the knee). **DOCKERS, POLO, ETC. ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.** Pre-K-1 boys are encouraged to wear elastic waist uniform shorts.

Sweaters (optional item): Navy cardigan or pullover uniform sweaters may be worn. **NO EMBLEMS** are allowed. **Non-uniform sweaters are not acceptable.**

Coats/Jackets: Only solid navy blue uniform jackets may be worn. Either the traditional uniform jacket with a gray lining or the polar fleece jacket available in pull-over or zipper may be worn. No other jackets will be acceptable. Any jacket may be worn outside.

Sweatshirts and Sweatpants (optional items): Only navy St. Aloysius logo sweatshirts/sweatpants may be worn. St. Aloysius team sweatshirts may be worn in grades 3-8. These can be ordered at School Time. No other sweatshirt or sweatpant is acceptable. Grades 5 – 8 may purchase hooded sweatshirts-this includes sports sweatshirts. Grades Pre-K – 8 may

also purchase St. Aloysius logo sweatpants. Sweatpants may only be worn on specified days. The dates for sweatpants will be announced each year depending on weather.

Belts:Boys in 2-8 must wear a solid navy blue, black, or brown belt with the uniform pants and shorts.

Shoes: Tennis shoes may be any color. Shoes may **not** have rollers, may **not** blink, and may **not** have sequins or shiny parts. Tennis shoes must have tied laces or Velcro straps. Slip on tennis shoes (mule or backless) are **not** allowed. Sandals, cleats, boots, and turf type shoes are **not** allowed. Navy, black, or brown hard-soled shoes may also be worn.

Socks: Solid black or white <u>crew or ankle socks</u>. Socks must be visible-no shows are not allowed. Small logos are allowed in black or white only.

Jewelry: The only acceptable jewelry is a watch and one religious medal or one cross (worn on gold/silver chain or black/ brown cord). High tech phone type watches and fitness bands may not be worn. Any device that has wireless capabilities and/or can receive notifications, text messages, or phone calls is not allowed.

Grooming: Hair must be of conservative length and thickness in front, back, top, and sides. Hair must be off the collar, above the ear, and above the eyebrows. It must be clean and neat. Shaven heads, weight lines, shaving, or carving into the natural hairline, dyed, bleached, or tinted hair, and the like are not acceptable. Hair should always have a dry appearance. Face must be clean shaven. No hair accessories. When a student is issued a warning slip for a haircut, it must be cut by the following Monday or additional consequences will be issued.

TERRA NOVA NEXT TESTING DATE CHANGE (Grades 2-8): Students in grades 3-8 will take Terra Nova NEXT Summative Testing on April 25, 26, and 27 from 8:00 a.m. to 9:20 a.m. (It was previously scheduled for April 24-26. Second grade students will take a practice test during the same testing period. Please do not schedule appointments during these times. Students in these grade levels (2-8) will NOT be able to check in or out of school from 8-9:20 on these days.

<u>MY ASCENSION:</u> In continuing to provide support for our students and families, St. Aloysius School is providing a virtual viewing of the inspirational film, My Ascension, for all <u>6th through</u> <u>8th grade families</u>. My Ascension is a documentary film and movement to spread hope and fight suicide. 
